




Lumimari





Lucerna





Shoes








The Key pendant is composed of ten regular keys. Everyone can find these types of keys in their pocket. All of them have small details that add beautiful zigzag detail and texture to the lamp's contour. The inner detail has been smoothened for better light reflection.

Sunglasses






The Sunglasses lamp is created by stacking twelve pairs of vintage sunglasses in the shape of a cone. Some glasses are facing inwards and others outwards. This gives the lamp an interesting bubbly surface.

Noble 6.2






Noble 6.2 is timeless and classical in a modern way. In addition to adjusting the brightness, the light's color temperature can be changed between 2700–6000K (tunable white).








Noble 8.0 chandelier features an LED light inside the frame, positioned behind the closely arranged crystal glass profiles. In addition to adjusting the brightness, the light's color temperature can be changed between 2700–6000K (tunable white). This model also works well with lower ceilings.



Noble 8.3






The Noble 8.3 chandelier creates a festive atmosphere with its crystal glass profiles while maintaining a classic chandelier shape. The profiles are arranged in a circular pattern across three staggered rings of varying sizes, using light sources with E14 sockets.



Rhizome



The Rhizome chandelier offers a distinctive aesthetic with its slender light elements, irregularly arranged and angled in various directions. Suspended freely from delicate cables, these elements form a unique composition. The design is especially well-suited for larger, multi-level spaces, creating an impressive ambiance whether viewed from below or above.


















The Office of the Chancellor of Justice
